Upon the application of the United States of America and the affirmation of Noah Solowiejczyk, Assistant United States Attorney for the Southern District of New York, it is found that the defendant was charged with violations of 18 U.S.C. §§ 371, 666, 1343, 1346, 1349, and 2, as set forth in the complaint *United States v. It is further found that the defendant was presented before Magistrate Judge James L. Cott on September 26, 2017, and was released subject to the conditions of his bail terms set by Magistrate Judge Cott;

Solowiejczyk, Edward B. Diskant, and Robert Boone, have been engaged in, and are continuing, discussions concerning a possible disposition of these cases;

It is further found that the Government has requested a continuance of 14 days to engage in further discussions with defense counsel about the disposition of these cases and that the defendant, through counsel, has consented that such a continuance may be granted for that purpose and has specifically waived his right to be charged in an indictment or information for an additional 14 days; and

It is further found that the granting of such a continuance best serves the ends of justice and outweighs the best interests of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial; and therefore it is

ORDERED that the request for a continuance pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A) is hereby granted until November 9, 2017, and that a copy of this Order and the affirmation of Assistant United States Attorney Noah Solowiejczyk be served by mail on this date on counsel for the defendant by the United States Attorney's Office.
